LEIBNIZ CHANCE

This pillar of the Leibniz Programme makes it possible to invite postdoctoral researchers who have **fled their home countries due to the political situation** and are looking for an opportunity to **continue their research** here.

It provides short-term financial support in the form of a monthly flat-rate allowance of 2600 euros gross for up to three months. Applicants should be in the process of securing longer-term funding for their continued stay at Leipzig University.

LEIBNIZ PROGRAMME

The Leibniz Programme at Leipzig University promotes academic exchange. It is international, interdisciplinary and intergenerational.

It comprises:

- the Leibniz Professorship for international researchers;
- the Leibniz MOBILITY programme; and
- Leibniz CHANCE for researchers with a refugee background.

LEIBNIZ PROFESSORSHIP

The Leibniz Professorship is awarded each semester to **distinguished and predominantly international** researchers. It is one of the highest awards bestowed by Leipzig University.

The Leibniz Professorship is for a W3 visiting professor who conducts interdisciplinary research and teaches classes for students and doctoral researchers. The aim is to stimulate partnerships, creating a foundation for academic innovation. We also hope to gain new ideas and input for the training of early career researchers. We would like to attract internationally renowned academics and researchers, primarily from countries outside Germany.



Proposals for the Leibniz Professorship can be submitted by any professor at Leipzig University.



LEIBNIZ INVITATIONS

With Leibniz INVITATIONS, we support **international visiting researchers at our university**. The main purpose of such exchange should be to provide a significant contribution to the support of doctoral researchers and postdocs. Proposals to invite visiting researchers can be submitted by professors as well as postdocs and doctoral researchers.

Guests can be invited for lectures, symposia, methodological workshops or direct academic exchange.

-  Length of stay
Up to five days, also longer if justified
-  Funding can cover
Travel and accommodation as well as remuneration or flat-rate allowance

Requirements for guests:

- Doctorate
- Participation in the training of doctoral researchers

LEIBNIZ TRAVEL

With Leibniz TRAVEL, we support **postdoctoral researchers at our university** who are planning an international stay that is focused on research and networking.

-  Length of stay
Up to five days, also longer if justified
-  Grant
max. 1000 euros within Europe
max. 1500 euros outside Europe
-  Funding can cover
Travel and accommodation

Application requirements:

- Registered as a postdoc at Leipzig University
- Employed by Leipzig University

Projects that can be supported:

- Invitations to hold a lecture at a university or research institute
- Participation in the organisation of conferences
- Travel to network meetings
- Research stays to learn new methods
- Only for early postdocs (no more than three years after dissertation): allowances to actively participate in international conferences
